

## ORCHIDS IN USE – FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS

### Rules and Regulations

1. There will be space available for exhibitors to prepare or finish their designs at the Show site from 12:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Friday, April 22, 2016.
2. Orchids must be the dominant cut flower used. All orchids must be fresh. They do not have to be grown by the exhibitor.
3. Other fresh flowers, foliage, dried and/or treated plant material and accessories are permitted in all classes. Lace leaves, ribbon buds, bows, etc. are permitted only in class 107, Orchids for personal adornments.
4. Each design must have been created by the exhibitor. The exhibitor need not be a member of an orchid society. An exhibitor may enter at most 3 entries.
5. All entries are eligible for ribbon awards in their class. Judges have the authority to award or withhold any ribbon or trophy.
6. All entries must be left in place until show closing time at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.
